Be Not Afraid of the King of Assyria

II Chronicles 32:7 Be **strong and courageous**, be <u>not afraid nor dismayed</u> for the king of Assyria, nor for all the multitude that is with him: for there be **more with us** than with him:

8 With <u>him is an arm of flesh</u>; but with **us is the LORD our God to help us**, and to **fight our battles**. And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah king of Judah.

This was spoke by King Hezekiah in the Old Testament.

However, Who is Modern Day Assyria?

<u>Assyria</u>: Ancient country in the Middle East, with it's center in <u>modern Iraq</u> along the Tigris and the Euphrates rivers which have their source in the Armenian mountains and run almost parallel as far south as Babylonia and Chaldea, flowing into the Persian Gulf. At its height in the 9th century BCE, Assyria also covered areas in modern eastern <u>Turkey</u>, <u>Syria</u>, <u>Lebanon</u>, <u>Palestine</u>, <u>western Iran</u>, <u>Kuwait</u> and <u>Egypt</u>.

We currently are in the early stages of WWIII that will lead us into the Battle of Armegeddon. It has been acknowledged by our President as well as Israel and many other nations that we are in the early stages of WWIII.

Who is the King of Assyria? The King of Assyria is Satan who will inhabit the

Anti-Christ in the very near future. So, what did the Prophet Isaiah say concerning **our modern day King of Assyria**.

Isaiah 30:25 And there shall be upon every high mountain, and upon every high hill, rivers and streams of waters in the **day of the great slaughter**, when the towers fall.

26 Moreover the <u>light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun</u>, and the **light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days**, in the <u>day</u> that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth the stroke of their wound.

27 Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, <u>burning with his anger</u>, and the <u>burden</u> thereof <u>is heavy</u>: **his lips are full of indignation**, and **his tongue as a devouring fire:**

28 And **his breath**, as an overflowing stream, <u>shall reach to the midst of the</u> <u>neck</u>, to **sift the nations with the sieve of vanity**: and there <u>shall be a bridle</u> in the jaws of the people, causing them to err.

Here we see that the Lord is burning with anger and His tongue as a devouring fire.

29 Ye shall <u>have a song</u>, <u>as</u> in the night when <u>a holy solemnity is kept</u>; and <u>gladness of heart</u>, as when one goeth with a pipe <u>to come into the mountain</u> <u>of the LORD</u>, to the mighty One of Israel.

Yet at the same time, the Children of God will be singing hymns unto the Lord and will have gladness in their heart.

30 And the **LORD shall cause his glorious voice to be heard**, and <u>shall show the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of his anger, and with the flame of a devouring fire, with scattering, and tempest, and hailstones.</u>

31 For <u>through the voice of the LORD</u> shall the **Assyrian be beaten down**, which smote with a rod.

32 And in every place where the grounded staff shall pass, which the LORD shall lay upon him, it shall be with tabrets and harps: and <u>in battles of shaking will he fight with it.</u>

33 For **Tophet** is ordained of old; yea, for the king it is prepared; he hath made it <u>deep and large</u>: the pile thereof <u>is fire and much wood</u>; the **breath of the LORD**, <u>like a stream of brimstone</u>, <u>doth kindle it</u>.

We'll explain Tophet and why it was ordained of old later in this lesson.

These scripture are referring to Revelation Chapter 16 and reads:

16:1 And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and <u>pour out the</u> vials of the wrath of God upon the earth.
2 And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image.

3 And the **second angel poured out his vial** upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man; and every living soul died in the sea.

4 And the **third angel poured out his vial** upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood.

5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, **Thou art righteous**, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, **because thou hast judged thus**.

6 For <u>they have shed the blood of saints and prophets</u>, and **thou hast given them blood to drink**; for **they are worthy**.

7 And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are thy judgments.

8 And the **fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun**; and power was given unto him **to scorch men with fire**.

Recall Isaiah 30:26

26 Moreover the <u>light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun</u>, and the **light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days**, in the <u>day</u> that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth the stroke of their wound.

(Con't Rev 16)

9 And men were <u>scorched with great heat</u>, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and <u>they repented not</u> to give him glory.

10 And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,
11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their

11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and the sores, and **repented not** of their deeds.

12 And the **sixth angel poured** out his vial upon the <u>great river Euphrates</u>; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the <u>kings of the east</u> <u>might be prepared</u>.

13 And <u>I saw three unclean spirits</u> like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue **Armageddon**.

The next part of the story comes from:

Isaiah 31

31:1 <u>Woe</u> to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and trust in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but <u>they look not unto the Holy One of Israel</u>, <u>neither seek the LORD</u>!

2 Yet **he also is wise**, and <u>will bring evil</u>, and **will not call back his words**: <u>but will arise against the house of the evildoers</u>, and <u>against the help of them</u> <u>that work iniquity</u>.

3 Now the Egyptians are men, and **not God**; and <u>their horses flesh</u>, and **not spirit.** When the <u>LORD shall stretch out his hand</u>, **both** <u>he that helpeth shall</u> <u>fall</u>, and he that is holpen shall fall down, and they all shall fail together</u>.

4 For **thus hath the LORD spoken** unto me, <u>Like as the lion and the young</u> <u>lion roaring on his prey</u>, when a multitude of shepherds is called forth against him, <u>he will not be afraid of their voice</u>, **nor abase himself** for the <u>noise of them</u>: so shall the <u>LORD of hosts come down to fight for mount</u> <u>Zion</u>, and <u>for the hill thereof</u>.

5 As birds flying, so **will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem**; <u>defending</u> <u>also he will deliver it</u>; and <u>passing over he will preserve it</u>.

6 <u>Turn ye unto him</u> from <u>whom the **children of Israel** have deeply</u> <u>revolted</u>.

7 For <u>in that day</u> every man shall cast away his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which your own hands have made unto you for a sin.

8 **Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword**, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited.

9 And he shall pass over to his strong hold for fear, and his princes shall be afraid of the ensign, saith the LORD, whose <u>fire is in Zion</u>, and <u>his</u> <u>furnace in Jerusalem</u>.

Take notice of the ensign being <u>fire is in Zion</u> and <u>His furnace in</u> <u>Jerusalem</u>.

(Con't Rev 16)

17 And the **seventh angel poured** out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, **It is done**.

18 And there were <u>voices</u>, and <u>thunders</u>, and <u>lightnings</u>; and there was a <u>great earthquake</u>, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so **mighty an earthquake**, and **so great**.

19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.
20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.
21 And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

Talent: approximately 90-120lbs.

Jeremiah the prophet tells us why Tophet was ordained of old and Tophet, being the whole valley of the Dead bodies, shall become Holy unto the Lord.

The Jer 31:35 **Thus saith the LORD**, which giveth the sun for a light by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divideth the sea when the waves thereof roar; The LORD of hosts is his name:

36 <u>If those ordinances depart from before me</u>, saith the LORD, then the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me for ever.
37 Thus saith the LORD; <u>If heaven above can be measured</u>, and <u>the foundations of the earth searched out beneath</u>, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel for all that they have done, saith the LORD.
38 Behold, <u>the days come</u>, saith the LORD, that <u>the city shall be built to the LORD</u> from the <u>tower of Hananeel</u> unto the gate of the corner.
39 And the <u>measuring line shall yet go forth over against it upon the hill Gareb</u>, and <u>shall compass about to Goath</u>.
40 And the <u>whole valley of the dead bodies</u>, and of the ashes, and <u>all the fields unto the brook of Kidron</u>, unto the corner of the horse gate toward the east, <u>shall be holy unto the LORD</u>; it shall not be plucked up, nor thrown

down any more for ever.

Why Tophet was ordained of old.

Jeremiah 7:29 Cut off thine hair, **O Jerusalem**, and cast it away, and **take up a lamentation on high places**; for **the LORD hath rejected and forsaken the generation of his wrath**.

30 For the <u>children of Judah have done evil in my sight</u>, saith the LORD: <u>they have set their abominations in the house which is called by my name, to pollute it.</u>

31 And <u>they have built the high places of **Tophet**</u>, which is <u>in the valley of</u> the son of Hinnom, to <u>burn their sons and their daughters in the fire</u>; which **I commanded them not**, neither came it into my heart.

32 <u>Therefore</u>, behold, <u>the days come</u>, saith the LORD, <u>that it shall no more</u> <u>be called Tophet</u>, nor the valley of the son of Hinnom, but the <u>valley of</u> **slaughter**: for they shall bury in Tophet, till there be no place.

33 And the <u>carcases of this people</u> shall <u>be meat for the fowls of the</u> heaven, and for the beasts of the earth; and none shall fray them away.

34 <u>Then will I cause to cease from the cities of Judah</u>, and <u>from the streets</u> of Jerusalem, the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the <u>voice of the</u> **bridegroom**, and **the voice of the bride**: for the land shall be desolate.

Here we see from verses 33 and 34 above, that Jeremiah is speaking of the supper of our great God which will be all <u>the Kings of the Earth</u> and <u>those</u> who did battle against Jerusalem at the **Battle of Armageddon**.

Revelation 19:11-21

11 And **I saw heaven opened**, and **behold a white horse**; and <u>he that sat</u> <u>upon him was called Faithful and True</u>, and <u>in righteousness he doth judge</u> <u>and make war</u>.

12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that <u>no man knew</u>, but he himself.

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

14 And the **armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses**, clothed in fine linen, **white and clean**.

15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
16 And he hath <u>on his vesture and on his thigh a name written</u>, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

17 And <u>I saw an angel standing in the sun</u>; and <u>he cried with a loud voice</u>, <u>saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven</u>, **Come and gather vourselves together unto the supper of the great God**;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

19 And I saw the beast (Anti-Christ), and <u>the kings of the earth</u>, and <u>their</u> armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which **sword proceeded out of his mouth**: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Revelation 14:10-12

10 The <u>same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God</u>, which <u>is</u> <u>poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation</u>; and <u>he shall</u> <u>be tormented with</u> fire and brimstone <u>in the presence</u> of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

11 And the smoke of their torment **ascendeth up for ever and ever**: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

12 <u>Here is the patience of the saints</u>: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

So we need Not Fear the King of Assyria because we are the Children of God and we will reign with Christ for ever and ever. AMEN.
