

Salvation, Redemption, and the Restoration of the Nation of Israel

Daniel 9:24

24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

In this lesson we will be focusing upon **the completion** of Daniel's seventieth week of years of which was spoken **against the Nation of Israel for their sins against God!** Upon the completion of the seventieth week of seven years we are told that it will accomplish the finishing of the transgressions of Israel, making an end of their sins, and will bring forth reconciliation for the iniquity of Israel, and at this same time will bring in everlasting righteousness!

For there to be a final seven years of Daniel's seventieth week of years that has not yet been completed, of which is referred to by most people as the tribulation period, **Messiah, which is Jesus the Christ, needed to be cut off out of the land of the living!** "And after threescore and two weeks shall **Messiah be cut off**, but not for himself: and **the people of the prince that shall come** shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined." (Daniel 9:26) "**He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.**" (Isaiah 53:7-8)

Matthew 27:22-25

22 Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus **which is called Christ?** They all say unto him, **Let him be crucified.**

23 And the governor said, **Why, what evil hath he done?** But they cried out the more, saying, **Let him be crucified.**

24 When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, **I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye to it.**

25 Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children.

The Jews who do not believe that their Messiah has come believe that Daniel's seventy weeks of years have already been fulfilled. **However, as we can see this is not correct.** This prophecy in Daniel speaking of **Messiah being cut off is directly tied to Jesus Christ from Isaiah who was also prophesying of Jesus Christ when speaking "for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken".**

We know this for sure according **to the book of Acts.** "Then **the Spirit said unto Philip,** Go near, and join thyself to this chariot. And Philip ran thither to him, **and heard him read the prophet Esaias,** and said, **Understandest thou what thou readest?** And he said, **How can I,**

except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him. The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth: In his humiliation his judgment was taken away: and who shall declare his generation? for his life is taken from the earth. And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? of himself, or of some other man? Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.” (Acts 8:29-35)

However, upon the completion of the seventieth week of years that was spoken to Daniel the Prophet by the angel Gabriel we are told that Israel will be restored! “Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.” (Daniel 9:24)

Romans 11:25-32

25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

26 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

27 For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

28 As concerning the gospel, they are enemies for your sakes: but as touching the election, they are beloved for the fathers' sakes.

29 For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.

30 For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief:

31 Even so have these also now not believed, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy.

32 For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all.

The reason for the seventy weeks of years that was pronounced against Israel was because of there continual disobedience and worshiping of idols. Therefore God turned to the Gentiles that we might also be saved while at the same time provoking Israel to jealousy!

Deuteronomy 32:16-38

16 They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger.

17 They sacrificed unto devils, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not.

18 Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee.

19 And when the LORD saw it, he abhorred them, because of the provoking of his sons, and of his daughters.

20 And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith.

21 They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

22 **For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest hell,** and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.

23 **I will heap mischiefs upon them; I will spend mine arrows upon them.**

24 They shall **be burnt with hunger, and devoured with burning heat, and with bitter destruction:** I will also send **the teeth of beasts** upon them, with **the poison of serpents** of the dust.

25 The **sword without, and terror within,** shall destroy both the young man and the virgin, the **suckling also with the man of gray hairs.**

26 I said, **I would scatter them into corners,** I would make the remembrance of them **to cease from among men:**

27 Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, and lest they should say, Our hand is high, and the LORD hath not done all this.

28 **For they are a nation void of counsel, neither is there any understanding in them.**

29 **O that they were wise, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end!**

30 **How** should one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, **except their Rock had sold them, and the LORD had shut them up?**

31 For their rock **is not as our Rock,** even our enemies themselves being judges.

32 For their vine is of the vine of **Sodom,** and of the fields of **Gomorrah:** their grapes are grapes of **gall,** their clusters are **bitter:**

33 Their wine is **the poison of dragons,** and the **cruel venom of asps.**

34 Is not this **laid up in store with me,** and sealed up among my treasures?

35 To me **belongeth vengeance, and recompence;** their foot shall slide in due time: for the day of **their calamity** is at hand, and the things that shall come upon them make haste.

36 **For the LORD shall judge his people,** and repent himself for his servants, when he seeth that their power is gone, and there is none shut up, or left.

37 And he shall say, Where are their gods, their rock in whom they trusted,

38 Which did eat the fat of their sacrifices, and drank the wine of their drink offerings? let them rise up and help you, and be your protection.

Romans 10:18-21

18 But I say, **Have they not heard? Yes verily,** their sound went into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world.

19 But I say, **Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by them that are no people, and by a foolish nation I will anger you.**

20 But Esaias is very bold, and saith, **I was found of them that sought me not; I was made manifest unto them that asked not after me.**

21 **But to Israel he saith, All day long I have stretched forth my hands unto a disobedient and gainsaying people.**

Isaiah 65:1-7

1 **I am sought of them that asked not for me; I am found of them that sought me not:** I said, Behold me, behold me, unto a nation that was not called by my name.

2 I have spread out my hands all the day unto a rebellious people, which walketh in a way that was not good, after their own thoughts;

3 A people that provoketh me to anger continually to my face; that sacrificeth in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick;

4 Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels;

5 Which say, Stand by thyself, come not near to me; for I am holier than thou. These are a smoke in my nose, a fire that burneth all the day.

6 Behold, it is written before me: I will not keep silence, but will recompense, even recompense into their bosom,

7 Your iniquities, and the iniquities of your fathers together, saith the Lord, which have burned incense upon the mountains, and blasphemed me upon the hills: therefore will I measure their former work into their bosom.

Romans 9:25-33

25 As he saith also in Osee, I will call them my people, which were not my people; and her beloved, which was not beloved.

26 And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God.

27 Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved:

28 For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth.

29 And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha.

30 What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of faith.

31 But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness.

32 Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone;

33 As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

It is for these reasons that the Lord God turned unto the gentiles! It was for these reasons that the Lord God pronounced upon the children of Israel seventy weeks of years! However, all Israel shall be saved! For the Lord God has a covenant with them when he shall "turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins." (Romans 11:26-27)

Romans 11:13-15

13 For I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I magnify mine office:

14 If by any means I may provoke to emulation them which are my flesh, and might save some of them.

15 For if the casting away of them **be the reconciling of the world**, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead?

Hebrews 8:7-13

7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.

8 For finding fault **with them**, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a **new covenant** with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; **because they continued not in my covenant**, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.

10 **For this is the covenant that I will make** with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; **I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:**

11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: **for all shall know me**, from the least to the greatest.

12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

13 **In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old.** Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.

It is this covenant that we, **both the Jew and the Gentile**, can now find **salvation** in this dispensation! **However, this is not the covenant that is in reference in Romans chapter 11:25-27.** “For I would not, brethren, that ye should be **ignorant of this mystery**, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; **that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.** **And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.**” (Romans 11:25-27)

Ephesians 2:13-22

13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off **are made nigh by the blood of Christ.**

14 For **he is our peace**, who hath made **both one**, and hath **broken down the middle wall of partition between us;**

15 **Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances;** for to make **in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;**

16 And that he might **reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:**

17 And came and preached **peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.**

18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, **but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;**

20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;

21 **In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:**

22 In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.

However, **upon the completion of this covenant and the end of the seventieth week of years** that was spoken to Daniel the Prophet, **the nation of Israel will have their sins and iniquities cleansed and everlasting righteousness will be ushered in!**

Ezekiel 28:24-26

24 And there shall be no more a pricking brier unto the house of Israel, nor any grieving thorn of all that are round about them, that despised them; and they shall know that I am the Lord GOD.

25 Thus saith the Lord GOD; When I shall have gathered the house of Israel from the people among whom they are scattered, and shall be sanctified in them in the sight of the heathen, then shall they dwell in their land that I have given to my servant Jacob.

26 **And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence,** when I have executed judgments upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I am the LORD their God.

Ezekiel 34:23-31

23 And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd.

24 And I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it.

25 **And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods.**

26 **And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing.**

27 **And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them.**

28 And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make them afraid.

29 And I will raise up for them a plant of renown, and they shall be no more consumed with hunger in the land, neither bear the shame of the heathen any more.

30 Thus shall they know that I the LORD their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, saith the Lord GOD.

31 And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekial 37:23-28

23 Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their God.

24 And David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.

25 And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and my servant David shall be their prince for ever.

26 Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.

27 My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

28 And the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.

Hosea 2:18-23 Brackets inserted by me

18 And in that day will I make a covenant for them with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven, and with the creeping things of the ground: and I will break the bow and the sword and the battle out of the earth, and will make them to lie down safely. {not fulfilled}

19 And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

20 I will even betroth thee unto me in faithfulness: and thou shalt know the LORD.

21 And it shall come to pass in that day, I will hear {to respond to}, saith the LORD, I will hear {to respond to} the heavens, and they shall hear {to respond to} the earth;

22 And the earth shall hear {to respond to} the corn, and the wine, and the oil; and they shall hear {to respond to} Jezreel. {God will sow}

23 And I will sow her {Israel} unto me in the earth; and I will have mercy upon her that had not obtained mercy; and I will say to them which were not my people, Thou art my people; and they shall say, Thou art my God.

Remember Hosea 2:18 And in that day will I make a covenant for them with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven, and with the creeping things of the ground: and I will break the bow and the sword and the battle out of the earth, and will make them to lie down safely. {not fulfilled}

Here we see the fulfillment in the Millennial Reign of Christ concerning the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven, and with the creeping things of the ground.

Isaiah 11:6-9 brackets inserted by me

6 The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; **and a little child shall lead them.**

7 And the **cow and the bear shall feed;** their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

8 And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp, and **the weaned child shall put his hand on the cockatrice' den.** {viper}

9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

Here we see the fulfillment in the Millennial Reign of Christ concerning I will break the bow and the sword and the battle out of the earth, and will make them to lie down safely.

Micah 4:1-3

1 But in the last days it shall come to pass, that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it.

2 And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

3 And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

Jeremiah 23:3-8

3 And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.

4 And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD.

5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

7 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that they shall no more say, The LORD liveth, which brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;

8 But, The LORD liveth, which brought up and which led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country, and from all countries whither I had driven them; and they shall dwell in their own land.

Zechariah 13:1-2, 6 brackets inserted by me

1 In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness. {not fulfilled}

2 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land. {not fulfilled}

6 And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends. {not fulfilled}
