

God Will Forever Abide Faithful

God will **never deny** himself. He will always be true. The world will pass away but God's **word will never** pass away.

We, like the Apostle Peter, in a time of fear, and distress, may deny we know Jesus in our conversations and in our actions; but let us weep bitterly for forgiveness, even as Peter wept bitterly for his denying Jesus during the Lord's suffering at the hands of the priests, for Peter **feared** that **he too** would be tortured and put to death.

Even though just a few hours earlier Peter had said he was ready to suffer with Christ and to also die with Him; and the other Apostles likewise all agreed to stay with Jesus even unto death.

But this is a Spiritual walk, a Spiritual calling. This is not a carnal; fleshly walk. For Jesus said, Not By Might; Not By Strength; But by my Spirit saith the Lord! Not he that willeth, nor he that runneth, but upon whom the Lord showeth mercy!

II Timothy 2:11-13

- 11 It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him:
- 12 If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us:
- 13 If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.

If we suffer with Jesus, we shall also reign, and rule with him: If We Deny Jesus, He Will Also Deny Us.

Deny us what? Deny us His Holy Spirit, and Everlasting Life. He will deny us His love, His mercy, His compassion, His peace, and joy. If we deny him, we deny ourselves His unmerited favor, and His eternal grace.

For we are saved by grace, through faith and that not of ourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:8-9

- 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
- 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

If we believe not; yet Jesus abides faithful, **He Can Not Deny Himself!**

Warning to the Church:

Matthew 10: 32-33

32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.

33 But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.

Church this is very serious, this is life or death. If we acknowledge Jesus to the world, He will acknowledge us in heaven. We will be saved by Jesus. But if we deny Him before the world, He will deny us in heaven. Church if we miss heaven; if our name is not written in the Book of Life; The Lamb's book—there is only one other place for our soul to spend eternity—that is the Lake of Fire, truly a place of weeping and wailing and gnashing of teeth where the worm dieth not and the fire is never quenched.
