Revelation 4:1-8 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will show thee things which must be hereafter.

2 And immediately I was in the spirit; and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

4 And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

6 And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four beasts full of eyes before and behind.

7 And the first beast was like a lion, and the second beast like a calf, and the third beast had a face as a man, and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle.

8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

What a job! Lord give me this job! To stand before your Throne continuously forever crying, HOLY, HOLY, HOLY!

Revelation 4:9-11 And when those beasts give glory and honor and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever,

10 The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Jesus Christ is worthy of all our love, all our praise, and all our worship. He is our Lord and Savior, for there is no other name given unto

man whereby we must be saved. Jesus said I am the way, the truth and the life. Jesus is the only door into heaven. Jesus said I am the bread of life and if any man eat this bread he shall never die, but have everlasting life.

Church there is a heaven to gain, and a hell to shun. In Jesus there is peace, love and joy. But Jesus said in hell there is weeping, wailing and gnashing of teeth, where the soul dieth not and the fire is never quenched. Jesus is crying save yourselves from this ungodly generation! On the Day of Pentecost, Apostle Peter preached the plan of salvation to all who cried out to him, **what must I do to be saved?** What must I do to go to heaven and not to hell when I die?

Acts 2:38-39 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

Peter said to all that desired to be saved, Repent,(tell Jesus you are sorry for your sins and turn away from all evil) and be Baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of your sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost, which is eternal life.

There is no other plan of salvation, no other hope of escaping hell. Jesus said if you love me, you will obey my commandments. Except you believe that Jesus is our Lord and Savior you shall die in your sins.

John 3:1-7 Reads, There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:

2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.

3 Jesus answered and said unto him, **Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.**

4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

5 **Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.**

6 **That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.**

7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Apostle Paul said, I beseech you therefore brethern by the mercies of God to present your bodies a living sacrifice holy and acceptable to God which is your reasonable service.

King David said in the Psalms, Create in me a clean heart O God, renew in me a right spirit, cast me not out of the presence and take not thy Holy Spirit from me.
