The Great and Dreadful Day of the Lord

Introduction: The Lord has shown me through scriptures, that all roads to the return of Jesus Christ, the rapture, lead to Armageddon. I have provided eight different scenarios of scripture passages to try to lock in this timing, by bringing our attention to the signs and wonders that we are looking for in the heavens and in the earth before his coming, and helping us to see a few common factors in the different scenarios. The signs are: blood, fire, pillars of smoke, the sun will be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood. I will occasionally place inside of brackets, what I believe are some things to take note of and what I believe they are.

I Timothy 4:1-6

- 1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the <u>latter times</u> some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to <u>seducing spirits</u>, and <u>doctrines of devils</u>;
- 2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;
- 3 <u>Forbidding to marry</u>, and commanding to <u>abstain from meats</u>, which God hath created to be <u>received</u> with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.
- 4 For every creature of God is good, and <u>nothing to be refused</u>, **if it be** <u>received</u> with thanksgiving:
- 5 For it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer.
- 6 If thou put <u>the brethren</u> in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished up in the <u>words of faith and of good doctrine</u>, whereunto thou hast attained.

II Timothy 3:1-9

- 1 This know also, that in the last days **perilous times** shall come.
- 2 For men shall be <u>lovers of their own selves</u>, <u>covetous</u>, <u>boasters</u>, <u>proud</u>, <u>blasphemers</u>, <u>disobedient to parents</u>, <u>unthankful</u>, <u>unholy</u>,
- 3 Without <u>natural affection</u>, <u>trucebreakers</u>, <u>false accusers</u>, <u>incontinent</u>, <u>fierce</u>, <u>despisers of those that are good</u>,
- 4 <u>Traitors</u>, <u>heady</u>, <u>highminded</u>, **lovers** <u>of pleasures</u> **more than** <u>lovers of God</u>;
- 5 Having <u>a form of godliness</u>, but **denying the power** thereof: <u>from such</u> **turn away**.
- 6 For of this sort <u>are they which creep into houses</u>, and <u>lead captive</u> silly women laden with sins, led away <u>with divers lusts</u>,
- 7 **Ever learning**, and <u>never able to come to the knowledge of the truth</u>.
- 8 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of <u>corrupt minds</u>, <u>reprobate concerning the faith</u>.
- 9 But they shall proceed no further: <u>for their folly shall be manifest unto all men</u>, as theirs also was.

Scenario 1:

II Peter 3:1-9

- 1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:
- 2 That ye may <u>be mindful of the words</u> which were spoken before <u>by the holy prophets</u>, <u>and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour</u>:
- 3 Knowing **this first**, that there shall come in the last days <u>scoffers</u>, <u>walking after</u> their own lusts,
- 4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.
- 5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- 6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:
- 7 But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.
- 8 But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that <u>one day</u> is with the Lord as <u>a</u> thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.
- 9 The <u>Lord is not slack</u> concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but <u>is longsuffering</u> to us-ward, <u>not willing that any should perish</u>, but that <u>all should</u> <u>come to repentance</u>.
- 10 But **the day of the Lord** will come as a **thief in the night**; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a <u>great noise</u>, and <u>the elements shall melt with fervent heat</u>, the earth also and the works that are therein <u>shall be burned up.</u>

I Thessalonians 5:1-11

- 1 But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have <u>no need</u> that I write unto you.
- 2 For yourselves know perfectly that **the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief** in the night.
- 3 For when they shall say, <u>Peace and safety</u>; then <u>sudden destruction cometh upon them</u>, as travail upon a woman with child; and <u>they shall not escape</u>.
- 4 But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.
- 5 Ye are all the **children of light**, and the **children of the day**: we are **not** of the night, **nor** of darkness.
- 6 Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.
- 7 For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.
- 8 But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

- 9 For <u>God hath not appointed us to **wrath**</u>, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 10 Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him.
- 11 Wherefore <u>comfort yourselves together</u>, and edify one another, even as also ye do.

II Thessalonians 1:6-12

- 6 Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you;
- 7 And to you who are troubled <u>rest with us</u>, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven <u>with his mighty angels</u>,
- 8 In **flaming fire** taking <u>vengeance on them</u> that <u>know not God</u>, and that <u>obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ</u>:
- 9 Who shall be punished with <u>everlasting destruction</u> from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;
- 10 When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.
- 11 Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would <u>count you worthy</u> <u>of this calling</u>, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the <u>work of faith</u> with power:
- 12 That the name of our **Lord Jesus Christ** may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Isaiah 30:25-33; 31:1-9

- 25 And there shall be upon every high mountain, and upon every high hill, rivers and streams of waters in the day of the great slaughter, when the towers fall.
- 26 Moreover the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth the stroke of their wound.
- 27 Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, <u>burning with his anger</u>, and the burden thereof <u>is heavy</u>: his <u>lips are full of indignation</u>, and his tongue as a **devouring fire**:
- 28 And <u>his breath</u>, as <u>an overflowing stream</u>, shall reach to the midst of the neck, <u>to sift the nations with the sieve of vanity</u>: and there <u>shall be a bridle in the jaws</u> of the people, causing them to err.
- 29 Ye shall <u>have a song</u>, as in the night when a holy solemnity is kept; and <u>gladness of heart</u>, as when one goeth with a pipe to come into the mountain of the LORD, to the mighty One of Israel.

- 30 And the LORD shall cause his glorious voice to be heard, and <u>shall show</u> the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of his anger, and with the **flame of a devouring fire**, with scattering, and tempest, and <u>hailstones</u>. [vial 7]
- 31 For through the voice of the LORD shall the Assyrian be beaten down, which smote with a rod.
- 32 And in every place where the grounded staff shall pass, which the LORD shall lay upon him, it shall be with tabrets and harps: and in <u>battles of shaking</u> will he fight with it.
- 33 For Tophet is ordained of old; yea, for the king it is prepared; he hath made it deep and large: the pile <u>thereof is fire</u> and much wood; the <u>breath of the LORD</u>, like <u>a stream of brimstone</u>, doth kindle it.
- 31:1 Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and trust in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but they look not unto the **Holy One of Israel**, neither seek the LORD!
- 2 Yet he also is wise, and will bring evil, and will not call back his words: but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of them that work iniquity.
- 3 Now the Egyptians are men, and **not God**; and their horses flesh, and **not spirit**. When the LORD shall stretch out his hand, both he that helpeth shall fall, and he that is holpen shall fall down, and <u>they all shall fail together</u>.
- 4 For thus hath the LORD spoken unto me, Like as the lion and the young lion roaring on his prey, when a multitude of shepherds is called forth against him, he will not be afraid of their voice, nor abase himself for the noise of them: so shall the LORD of hosts come down to fight for mount Zion, and for the hill thereof.
- 5 As **birds flying**, so will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem; defending also he will deliver it; and passing over he will preserve it. [supper of the great God]
- 6 Turn ye unto him from whom the children of Israel have deeply revolted.
- 7 For **in that day** every man shall cast away his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which your own hands have made unto you for a sin.
- 8 Then shall the Assyrian fall **with the sword,** <u>not of a mighty man;</u> and the sword, <u>not of a mean man</u>, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited. [out of his (Jesus) mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations]
- 9 And he shall pass over to his strong hold for fear, and his princes shall be afraid of the ensign, saith the LORD, whose <u>fire is in Zion</u>, and his **furnace in Jerusalem**.

Matthew 13:36-43;49-50

36 Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field.

- 37 He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man;
- 38 The <u>field is the world</u>; the <u>good seed are the children of the kingdom</u>; but the <u>tares are the children of the wicked one</u>;
- 39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.
- 40 As therefore the tares are gathered and **burned in the fire**; so shall it be in the **end of this world**.
- 41 The <u>Son of man shall send forth his angels</u>, and they shall gather out of his kingdom <u>all things that offend</u>, and <u>them which do iniquity</u>;
- 42 And shall cast them into **a furnace of fire**: there shall be <u>wailing and gnashing</u> of teeth.
- 43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father.
- 49 So shall it be at **the end of the world**: the <u>angels shall come forth</u>, and <u>sever</u> the wicked from among the just,
- 50 And shall cast them into **the furnace of fire**: there shall be <u>wailing and gnashing of teeth</u>.

Revelation 14:14-20;

- 14 And I looked, and **behold a white cloud**, and upon the cloud one sat like unto **the Son of man**, having on his head <u>a golden crown</u>, and in his hand a **sharp sickle**.
- 15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.
- 16 And <u>he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle</u> on the earth; and the earth was reaped.
- 17 And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he <u>also having a sharp sickle</u>.
- 18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had **power over fire**; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the <u>clusters of the vine of the earth</u>; for her grapes are fully ripe.
- 19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and <u>cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God</u>. [Armageddon] 20 And the <u>winepress was trodden</u> without the city, and <u>blood came out of the</u> winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred

furlongs.

Scenario 2:

I Corinthians 15:51-54

- 51 Behold, <u>I show you a mystery</u>; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at **the last trump**: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- 53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.
- 54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

I Thessalonians 4:13-18

- 13 But <u>I would not have you to be ignorant</u>, brethren, <u>concerning them which are asleep</u>, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.
- 14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.
- 15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.
- 16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the **voice of the archangel**, and with the **trump of God**: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
- 17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
- 18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

II Thessalonians 2:1-6

- 1 Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,
- 2 That ye <u>be not soon shaken in mind</u>, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.
- 3 Let <u>no man deceive you by any means</u>: for that day shall not come, except there come <u>a falling away first</u>, and that <u>man of sin be revealed</u>, the **son of perdition**;
- 4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.
- 5 Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?
- 6 And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

Daniel 11:31-45; 12:1-4

- 31 And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.
- 32 And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God **shall be strong**, and **do exploits**.
- 33 And they that understand among the people shall instruct many: yet they shall fall by the sword, and by flame, by captivity, and by spoil, **many days**.
- 34 Now when they shall fall, they shall be holpen with a little help: but many shall cleave to them with flatteries.
- 35 And some of them of understanding shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: because it is yet for a time appointed.
- 36 And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.
- 37 Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself <u>above all</u>.
- 38 But in his estate shall he honour the <u>God of forces</u>: and a god whom his fathers <u>knew not</u> shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things.
- 39 Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge and increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.
- 40 And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over.
- 41 He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.
- 42 He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape.
- 43 But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians shall be at his steps.
- 44 But <u>tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him</u>: therefore he shall go forth **with great fury to destroy**, and utterly <u>to make away many</u>.
- 45 And <u>he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain</u>; yet **he shall come to his end**, and <u>none shall help him</u>.

- 12:1 And <u>at that time shall **Michael** stand up</u>, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be **a time of trouble**, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and **at that time thy people shall be delivered**, every one that shall be found written in the book.
- 2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.
- 3 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

Compare Matthew 13:43 with verse 3 above

- 41 The <u>Son of man shall send forth his angels</u>, and they shall gather out of his kingdom <u>all things that offend</u>, and <u>them which do iniquity</u>;
- 42 And shall cast them into **a furnace of fire**: there shall be <u>wailing and gnashing</u> of teeth.
- 43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father.
- 4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and <u>seal the book, even to the time of the end</u>: many shall run <u>to and fro</u>, and <u>knowledge shall be increased</u>.

Job 38:22-23

- 22 Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail, [Vial 7]
- 23 Which I have reserved against **the time of trouble**, against the day of battle and war? [Armageddon] [Also compare this verse with Daniel 12:1 above]

Revelation 10:7

7 But in the days of the <u>voice of the seventh angel</u>, when <u>he shall begin to sound</u>, the **mystery of God should be finished**, as <u>he hath declared to his servants the prophets</u>.

Revelation 11:15-17

- 15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.
- 16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,
- 17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.
- 18 And the <u>nations were angry</u>, and **thy wrath is come**, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants

the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.

19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there <u>were lightnings</u>, and <u>voices</u>, and <u>thunderings</u>, and an earthquake, and **great hail**. [Vial 7, Seal Six, Trumpet 7]

Scenario 3:

Revelation 6:9-17; 7:1-17;8:1

- 9 And when he had opened the **fifth seal**, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were <u>slain for the word of God</u>, and for the testimony which they held:
- 10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, **How long**, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- 11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.
- 12 And I beheld when he had opened the **sixth seal**, and, lo, there was <u>a great earthquake</u>; and the <u>sun became black as sackcloth of hair</u>, and the <u>moon became as blood</u>; [signs & wonders in heavens and earth]
- 13 And the <u>stars of heaven fell unto the earth</u>, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.
- 14 And the <u>heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together</u>; and <u>every mountain and island were moved out of their places</u>.
- 15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;
- 16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and <u>from the **wrath** of the Lamb</u>:
- 17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? [Compare to Revelation 11:18 And the <u>nations were angry</u>, and **thy wrath is come**, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and <u>them that fear thy name</u>, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.]
- 7:1 And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.
- 2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the <u>seal of the living</u> <u>God</u>: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea.

- 3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, <u>till we have sealed the</u> servants of our God in their foreheads.
- 4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.
- 5 Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.
- 6 Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nephthalim were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.
- 7 Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.
- 8 Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand. [144,000 are sealed and church raptured at same time as seen in verse9.]
- 9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;
- 10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, <u>Salvation to our God</u> which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.
- 11 And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God,
- 12 Saying, Amen: <u>Blessing</u>, and <u>glory</u>, and <u>wisdom</u>, and <u>thanksgiving</u>, and <u>honour</u>, and <u>power</u>, and <u>might</u>, be unto our God <u>for ever and ever</u>. **Amen**.
- 13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?
- 14 And <u>I said unto him</u>, <u>Sir</u>, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which <u>came out of great tribulation</u>, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
- 15 Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.
- 16 They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.
- 17 <u>For the Lamb</u> which is in the midst of the throne <u>shall feed them</u>, and <u>shall lead them unto living fountains of waters</u>: and <u>God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.</u>
- 8:1 And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was <u>silence in heaven about</u> the space of half an hour.

- 28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that <u>I will pour out my spirit upon all</u> <u>flesh</u>; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:
- 29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.
- 30 And I will **show wonders in the heavens and in the earth**, <u>blood</u>, and <u>fire</u>, and pillars of smoke. [Armageddon]
- 31 The <u>sun shall be turned into darkness</u>, and the <u>moon into blood</u>, before **the great and the terrible day of the LORD come**. [signs and wonders we are looking for.]
- 32 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

Zep 1:14-16

- 14 The great day of the LORD is near, it is near, and hasteth greatly, even the voice of the day of the LORD: the mighty man shall cry there bitterly.
- 15 That day <u>is a day of wrath</u>, <u>a day of trouble and distress</u>, <u>a day of wasteness and desolation</u>, <u>a day of darkness and gloominess</u>, <u>a day of clouds and thick darkness</u>,
- 16 A day of the trumpet and alarm against the fenced cities, and against the high towers.
- 17 And <u>I will bring distress upon men</u>, that <u>they shall walk like blind men</u>, because <u>they have sinned against the LORD</u>: and **their blood shall be poured out as dust**, and **their flesh as the dung**.
- 18 Neither their silver nor their gold shall be able to deliver them in the day of the LORD'S wrath; but the whole land shall be devoured by the fire of his jealousy: for he shall make even a speedy riddance of all them that dwell in the land.

Acts 2:19-21

- 19 And <u>I will show wonders in heaven above</u>, and <u>signs in the earth beneath</u>; **blood**, and **fire**, and **vapour of smoke**: [Armageddon]
- 20 The <u>sun shall be turned into darkness</u>, and the <u>moon into blood</u>, before that **great and notable day of the Lord come**: [Seal 6]
- 21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Scenario 4:

Matthew 24:1-51

- 1 And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to show him the buildings of the temple.
- 2 And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.
- 3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, **when** <u>shall these things be?</u> and **what** <u>shall be the sign of thy</u> coming, and of the end of the world?
- 4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- 5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.
- 6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.
- 7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.
- 8 All these are the beginning of sorrows.
- 9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. [Lead up to Seal 5]
- 10 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.
- 11 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.
- 12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- 13 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.
- 14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.
- [That was a part of the answer. From here down is descriptive of the time before the end]
- 15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)
- 16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:
- 17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:
- 18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.
- 19 And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!
- 20 But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:
- 21 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. [This identifies the last 3.5yrs as Great Tribulation being triggered by the abomination]
- 22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened. [Church is the Elect]
- 23 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not.

- 24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- 25 **Behold**, <u>I have told you before</u>.
- 26 Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not.
- 27 For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.
- 28 For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together. [Here the Lord has answered where it will take place. Armageddon, The supper of our Great God, and then tells us about the signs of His coming like the prophet Joel and the books of Acts has told us to look for.]
- 29 **Immediately after** the tribulation of those days shall <u>the sun be darkened</u>, and the <u>moon shall not give her light</u>, and the <u>stars shall fall from heaven</u>, and the <u>powers of the heavens shall be shaken</u>: [Seal 6]
- 30 **And then** shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the <u>tribes of the earth mourn</u>, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- 31 And <u>he shall send his angels with a **great sound of a trumpet**</u>, and they shall gather together **his elect** from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. [Church is the Elect]
- 32 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, <u>ye know that summer is nigh</u>:
- 33 So <u>likewise</u> ye, <u>when ye shall see all these things</u>, <u>know that it is near</u>, even at the doors.
- 34 Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass**, till all these things be fulfilled.
- 35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
- 36 But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.
- 37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.
- 38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,
- 39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.
- 40 Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.
- 41 Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.
- 42 **Watch therefore**: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.

- 43 But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the **thief** would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up.
- 44 Therefore be ye also ready: <u>for in such an hour as ye think not</u> the Son of man cometh.
- 45 Who then <u>is a faithful and wise servant</u>, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?
- 46 <u>Blessed is that servant</u>, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- 47 Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods.
- 48 But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming;
- 49 And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken;
- 50 The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of,
- 51 And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Revelation 19:11-21

- 11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called <u>Faithful and True</u>, and <u>in righteousness he doth judge and make war</u>.
- 12 His eyes were as a **flame of fire**, and <u>on his head</u> were **many crowns**; and he had <u>a name written</u>, that **no man knew**, <u>but he himself</u>.
- 13 And he was <u>clothed with a vesture dipped in blood</u>: and **his name** is called <u>The</u> Word of God.
- 14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.
- 15 And **out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword**, that with it <u>he should smite the nations</u>: and <u>he shall rule them with a rod of iron</u>: and he **treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God**. [Armageddon]
- 16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.
- 17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;
- 18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.
- 19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

- 20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. [The Furnace in Jerusalem, Isaiah 31:9]
- 21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Scenario 5:

Mark 13:1-33

- 13:1 And as he went out of the temple, one of his disciples saith unto him, Master, see what manner of stones and what buildings are here!
- 2 And Jesus answering said unto him, Seest thou these great buildings? there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.
- 3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives over against the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew asked him privately,
- 4 Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign when all these things shall be fulfilled?
- 5 And Jesus answering them began to say, Take heed lest any man deceive you:
- 6 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.
- 7 And when ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars, be ye not troubled: for such things must needs be; but the end shall not be yet.
- 8 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be famines and troubles: **these are the beginnings of sorrows**.
- 9 But take heed to yourselves: for <u>they shall deliver you up to councils</u>; and in the <u>synagogues ye shall be beaten</u>: and <u>ye shall be brought before rulers and kings for my sake</u>, for **a testimony against them**.
- 10 And the gospel must first be published among all nations.
- 11 But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up, <u>take no thought beforehand</u> what ye shall speak, <u>neither do ye premeditate</u>: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: <u>for it is not ye that speak</u>, **but the Holy Ghost**. [Lead up to Seal 5]
- 12 Now the brother shall betray the brother to death, and the father the son; and children shall rise up against their parents, and shall cause them to be put to death.
- 13 And ye shall be hated of all men **for my name's sake**: but <u>he that shall endure unto the end</u>, the same **shall be saved**.

- 14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:
- 15 And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, to take any thing out of his house:
- 16 And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment.
- 17 But woe to them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!
- 18 And pray ye that your flight be not in the winter.
- 19 For in those days shall be affliction, such as was not from the beginning of the creation which God created unto this time, neither shall be.

[This identifies the last 3.5yrs as Great Tribulation being triggered by the abomination]

20 And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the **elect's sake**, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days. [Church is the Elect]

- 21 And then if any man shall say to you, Lo, here is Christ; or, lo, he is there; believe him not:
- 22 For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall show signs and wonders, to seduce, <u>if it were possible</u>, even the elect.
- 23 But take ye heed: **behold**, **I have foretold you all things**.
- 24 **But in those days, <u>after</u> that tribulation**, the <u>sun shall be darkened</u>, and the <u>moon shall not give her light</u>,
- 25 And the <u>stars of heaven shall fall</u>, and the <u>powers that are in heaven shall be</u> shaken.

[Seal 6 and the signs of His coming like the prophet Joel and the books of Acts has told us to look for.]

- 26 **And then** shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.
- 27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together **his elect** from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven. [Church is the Elect]
- 28 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When her branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, <u>ye know that summer is near</u>:
- 29 So ye in like manner, when ye shall see these things come to pass, know that it is nigh, even at the doors.
- 30 Verily I say unto you, **that this generation shall not pass**, till all these things be done.
- 31 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
- 32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.

33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.

Scenario 6:

Luke 17:22-37

- 22 And he said unto the disciples, The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the Son of man, and ye shall not see it.
- 23 And they shall say to you, See here; or, see there: **go not after them**, <u>nor</u> follow them.
- 24 For as the lightning, that lighteneth out of the one part under heaven, shineth unto the other part under heaven; so shall also the Son of man **be in his day**.
- 25 But first must be suffer many things, and be rejected of this generation.
- 26 And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.
- 27 They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and **destroyed them all**.
- 28 Likewise <u>also as it was in the days of Lot</u>; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;
- 29 But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and **destroyed them all**.
- 30 Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed.
- 31 In that day, he which shall be upon the housetop, and his stuff in the house, let him not come down to take it away: and he that is in the field, let him likewise not return back.
- 32 Remember Lot's wife.
- 33 Whosoever shall seek to save his life shall lose it; and whosoever shall lose his life shall preserve it.
- [This identifies the last 3.5yrs as Great Tribulation being triggered by the abomination]
- 34 I tell you, in that night there shall be two men in one bed; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left.
- 35 Two women shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and the other left.
- 36 Two men shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.
- 37 And they answered and said unto him, Where, Lord? And he said unto them,

Wheresoever the body is, thither will the eagles be gathered together.

[Here the Lord has answered where it will take place. Armageddon, The supper of our Great God.]

Luke 21:5-36

- 5 And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he said,
- 6 As for these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.
- 7 And they asked him, saying, **Master**, but **when** <u>shall these things be</u>? and **what sign** will there be when these things shall come to pass?
- 8 And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for **many** shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and <u>the time draweth near</u>: go ye not therefore after them.
- 9 But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; but the <u>end is not by and by.</u>
- 10 Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom:
- 11 And <u>great earthquakes</u> shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and <u>fearful sights and great signs</u> shall there be from heaven.

[Here Luke has told us out of order what is to come by telling us about Seal 6 and the signs of His coming like the prophet Joel and the books of Acts has told us to look for.]

- 12 **But before all these**, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake.
- 13 And it shall turn to you for a testimony.
- 14 Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer:
- 15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. [Lead up to Seal 5]
- 16 And ye shall be <u>betrayed both by parents</u>, and <u>brethren</u>, and <u>kinsfolks</u>, and <u>friends</u>; and <u>some of you shall</u> they cause to <u>be put to death</u>.
- 17 And <u>ye shall be hated of all men</u> for my name's sake.
- 18 But there shall not an hair of your head perish.
- 19 In your **patience** possess **ye your souls**.
- 20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.
- 21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.
- 22 For these be <u>the days of vengeance</u>, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.
- 23 But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people.

[Again, Luke has told us out of order. This identifies the last 3.5yrs as Great Tribulation being triggered by the abomination]

- 24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, **until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled**.
- 25 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring;
- 26 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.

[Armageddon, Rapture, and then Romans 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, <u>until the fulness of the Gentiles be</u> come in.

- 26 And so <u>all Israel shall be saved</u>: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the **Deliverer**, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:
- 27 For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.]

Luke 21 (continuing)

- 27 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.
- 28 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.

[Zechariah 13:6 And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.

- 7 Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.
- 8 And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the LORD, two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left therein.
- 9 And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, The LORD is my God. Luke 13:34 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not!
- 35 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate: and verily I say unto you, Ye shall not see me, until the time come when ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.

Zechariah 14

- 1 Behold, **the day of the LORD cometh**, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.
- 2 For <u>I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle</u>; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.
- 3 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. {verses 4-7; Seal 6, Vial 7}
- 4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall <u>cleave in the midst thereof</u> toward the east and toward the west, and there <u>shall be a very great valley</u>; and <u>half</u> of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.
- 5 And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.
- 6 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the light shall not be clear, nor dark:
- 7 But it shall be **one day which shall be known to the LORD**, <u>not day</u>, <u>nor night</u>: but it shall come to pass, that <u>at evening time it shall be light</u>.]

Luke 21 (continuing)

- 29 And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees;
- 30 When they now shoot forth, <u>ye see and know of your own selves that summer is now nigh at hand</u>.
- 31 So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand.
- 32 Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass away**, till all be fulfilled.
- 33 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
- 34 And take heed to yourselves, <u>lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting</u>, and <u>drunkenness</u>, and <u>cares of this life</u>, and <u>so that day come upon you unawares</u>.
- 35 For as a **snare** shall it come on <u>all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth</u>.
- 36 **Watch** ye therefore, and <u>pray always</u>, that <u>ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass</u>, and **to stand** <u>before the Son of man</u>.

Scenario 7:

Revelation 16:12-21

- 12 And the **sixth angel poured out his vial** upon the <u>great river Euphrates</u>; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.
- 13 And <u>I saw three unclean spirits</u> like frogs come <u>out of the mouth of the dragon</u>, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.
- 14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty. [Armageddon]
- 15 Behold, **I come as a thief**. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame. [Rapture]
- 16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.
- 17 And the **seventh angel poured out his vial into the air**; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, **It is done**.
- 18 And there <u>were voices</u>, and <u>thunders</u>, and <u>lightnings</u>; and there was <u>a great earthquake</u>, such as was not since men were upon the earth, <u>so mighty an</u> earthquake, and so great.
- 19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.
- 20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.
- 21 And there fell upon men **a great hail out of heaven**, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men <u>blasphemed God</u> because of the plague of the hail; for <u>the plague thereof was exceeding great</u>. [Seal 6, Seal 7, Trumpet 7, Vial 7]

Job 38:22-23

- 22 Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or <u>hast thou seen the treasures</u> of the hail, [Vial 7]
- 23 Which I have reserved against **the time of trouble**, against <u>the day of battle and war</u>? [Armageddon]

<u>Scenario 8</u>:

Ezekiel 38:17-23

- 17 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Art thou he of whom I have spoken in old time by my servants the prophets of Israel, which prophesied in those days many years that I would bring thee against them?
- 18 And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, that my fury shall come up in my face.

- 19 For in **my jealousy** and in the **fire of my wrath** have I spoken, Surely in **that day** there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel;
- 20 So that the <u>fishes of the sea</u>, and the <u>fowls of the heaven</u>, and the <u>beasts of the field</u>, and <u>all creeping things that creep upon the earth</u>, and <u>all the men that are upon the face of the earth</u>, **shall shake at my presence**, and the <u>mountains shall be thrown down</u>, and the <u>steep places shall fall</u>, and <u>every wall shall fall to the ground</u>.
- 21 And <u>I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains</u>, saith the Lord GOD: every man's sword shall be against his brother.
- 22 And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood; and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that are with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone.

[Seal 6, Seal 7, Trumpet 7, Vial 7]

23 Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD.

Revelation 17:10-14

- 10 And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue <u>a short space</u>.
- 11 And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.
- 12 And the <u>ten horns</u> which thou sawest are <u>ten kings</u>, which have received <u>no kingdom as yet</u>; but receive power as kings <u>one hour</u> with the beast.
- 13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.
- 14 <u>These shall make war with the **Lamb**</u>, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are <u>called</u>, and <u>chosen</u>, and <u>faithful</u>.

Revelation 3:7-11

- 7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;
- 8 I know thy works: behold, I have set <u>before thee an open door</u>, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast <u>kept my word</u>, and <u>hast not denied my name</u>.
- 9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, <u>but do lie</u>; **behold**, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that **I have loved thee**.

- 10 Because **thou hast kept the word of my patience**, I also will keep thee from the **hour** of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.
- 11 Behold, I come quickly: <u>hold that fast which thou hast</u>, that no man take thy crown.
