We Have Something Greater

Psalms 27:4 King David spoke:

4 One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in his temple.

Though King David was king of all Israel-though he could have any earthly desire yet he proclaimed; One thing have I desired (the scripture tells us King David was a man after God's own heart. But we have something greater than King David had!

1 Corinthians 3:16

16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?
